Calvin is a Member of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and a HKIAC Accredited Tribunal Secretary. He self-studied and passed the mainland China bar exam (the National Uniform Legal Profession Qualification Examination) in 2018.

Calvin further obtained his LLM degree with Distinction (ranking no. 6 out of 236 students) at University of California, Los Angeles in 2022, where he ranked first in Arbitration Law, Patent Litigation and US Constitutional Law for Foreign Lawyers, and was selected as the class speaker for the LLM Class at the graduation ceremony.
